Position Summary: Bendigo Foodshare Inc. sources and distributes donated food across Central Victoria and acts as a distribution point for food from statewide food collection agencies. It partners with other organisations to seek ways to help people in Central Victoria to improve their food security. The Manager is responsible for implementing the Strategic Plan as agreed with the Board of Bendigo Foodshare, the management of paid staff and volunteers, and the efficient and safe operation of Bendigo Foodshare program.

The position is based at the Bendigo Foodshare warehouse, currently located at Shed 2, 43A Havilah Rd, Long Gully.
